


and I have set two practice dates for April. If everyone will do their best to become proficient, I believe we will be fine.

## A tour of the Temple

Over the past few months you have read a great deal about the project called 'Save the Temple" and how much it will take to insure the future of this magnificent building on the corner of Ninth Street and Market Avenue North. Maybe it's time to talk about why we should save this great building. There is much more to this building than the average person can comprehend. There are nooks and crannies you can not imagine tucked away that do things to support the use of that building. Let's take a short tour of areas of the Canton Masonic Temple as a maintenance personnel or custodian would see them.


We have all entered from that ninth Street door and through the security office landing; down the several steps to the vestibule. Do you remember when the second set of doors and the security office were added? The Ninth Street entrance used to come straight into the building. Looking across the polished marble vestibule floor to the large swinging doors leading to the dining room steps, these were added to the decor some 20 years ago to stop the draft, when the entry doors were opened, from running down the steps and across the dining room floor. Did you know there was to be a second elevators installed in the building also? At construction, the space was allotted for the second unit but was

never installed because of cost. Even the plastered framework was installed. This, no mans area, has long ago been used to short cut electrical wiring and plumbing and is no longer available for the elevator installation.



picture high above the Maintenance room floor? And did you ever wonder where the fresh air comes from in the Cathedral Room when the doors are closed tightly. Pictured is the monster circulating air fan and duct work which exchanges the air in this Cathedral Room several times an hour, keeping the oxygen content at a good level. Those architects seem to have thought of everything didn't they?





How many times have you stood in the kitchen and looked down the ramp at the two large heat generators in the boiler room. But have you ever viewed them from the vantage point shown on this





As you sit in that Cathedral Room and watch stage scenery changing wondering

how did that ever happen, well this picture will explain the rope room, located far above the stage, where some 86 different stations and ropes are located for scenery are available! Even the lighting bars, over the stage, may be lowered to working level from this area. This room is reached from floor 2M and is accessed through another room where many props and robes are stored. These are areas that most brethren never see but I'm sure all wondered


if they exist. Well brethren, they do exist and over the next few months as I take more pictures, you will see them.

Now let's now move down one floor to the Blue Lodge Room and look west towards the organ loft. You have all seen the winding steps going up to this balcony and loft from the preparation room, but did you ever wonder about the Techantz Pipe Organ housed in this area. Built in 1926 and still useable for beautiful music today,




the musician sits, is located behind an ornamental grid seen from the floor of the room. Over the years I have enjoyed the music from this magnificent instrument and wish it could last forever. Another interesting part of the Blue Lodge Room is the Blazing Star located high above the altar in the ceiling. Did you ever wonder how the electric light bulb is changed in that Blazing Star? Well in future articles I





it is one of the crowning glories of this entire Canton Masonic Temple. Very few of these organs still exist because the technology for maintenance and repairing is a dying art. The pipes, flutes and bases are stationed and suspended in a humidity controlled environment shown here behind a closed door. The air pump is located close by in a sound proofed room. The manual, the keyboard and peddles where



will take you to where that happens and you'll be among the very few, perhaps only eight or ten Masonic members, who know where to go to do this task.

Located outside the Blue Lodge Room is the Lounge or Board Room. This room had couches and over stuffed chairs with a TV in it for years until the Board Room Table was moved into it. This long table

was located in the A.A.S.R. Office for years until the office was redecorated and the Board Table was moved into this room. This is where many of the decisions about this fine old building are discussed. Also located in this room is the World War Honor Roll of Master Masons. I can remember as a young lad first entering this room and viewing this large plaque with some, not a great deal, of stars placed beside the respective names. Now I believe every name has a memorial star attached beside it.



My Brethren, as I take more pictures of

this building, I will relate them to you so you may also be reminded of just why we as Canton Masons are being asked to dig down deep and save this fine old building. We have not touched the tip of the iceberg, so to speak, of the places we will travel. You will be amazed at the areas we have yet to go.
