
Thank you to all the brothers who helped deliver poinsettias and helped set up for the Masonic Christmas Morning Breakfast; we all had a great time.



A Tour of the Temple



Travel by camera with me into the unknown!

In keeping with our promos of taking the brethren, by camera, to places where they would probably never see or go in this magnificent old Masonic Temple building, I have chosen this month, the Blazing Star located high above the Altar in the Blue Lodge Room. Namely, how would one change the electric bulb in this bull's eye fixture? Obviously, from above! So armed with camera, flashlight, companion and an arm full of spare light bulbs, we



set out to go into the bowels of the building to record our journey. The location of the access to that area has been moved over the years when the fresh air venting was added and



later the massive air conditioning system. We now find the new entry area under the Cathedral Room seating on the South side of the room under the bleachers, covered with not used any longer props, for Scottish Rite Degrees. The not easily found, hidden by an old piece of plywood, entryway leads down a wooden constructed ladder to a cat walk somewhere above the Cryptic Room Ceiling. Quarters are cramped and obstructed by construc-

tion beaming and insulated vent piping for the air conditioning system. Crawling and stepping over beams and ceiling bridging, we come to the short ladder in the foreground,

is the bridge build over the main duct work for the cooling system which must be traversed. The head room is in the neighborhood of four and a half and five feet. Picture taking is difficult because of tight quarters and building beaming. Climbing this obstacle, we next find the area above the double hallways between the Cryptic and Blue Lodge Rooms. Head room here is a little greater because of heights of the two rooms under us. Ahead



in inadequate lighting and several feet above the hallway ceiling level, lays the cat walk Continued on page 13

over the Blue Lodge area. After installing several new light bulbs, we proceed on our journey. At the end of this boarded walkway and off to the right, is the light fixture suspended with frame work. The electrical connection can be seen on the deck connecting the fixture to power and controls. With thumb screws, the cover may be removed, which we did not do because of age and time restrictions, a new




are cables and braces everywhere keeping things in place. Ahead stands the wooden ladder which will take us back up several feet, through the little opening in the floor and to the level of the Cathedral Room area, good lighting and safety.




