Our Hidden Treasure

Tschantz Pipe Organ



In this year of Grand Master, Norman J. Mick's motto of: "Freemasonry...A Timeless Treasure," it was suggested that for the "Tour of the Temple" article this month, I spotlight an article of several years ago written by my predecessor, Gary Cox, entitled, "Our Hidden Treasure." I must admit that I had to dig deeply into the archives to come up with it and I shall attempt to use as much of the original article as possible, only rewriting what I deem necessary to fully explain this beautiful piece of historic equipment.

Hidden behind the decorative lattice at the rear of the Symbolic (Blue) Lodge Room of the Canton Masonic Temple, stands a treasure few have ever seen. Its melodious voices have enhanced our Degree Work, announced dignitaries at Installations and Inspections, and provided many hours of pure entertainment and enjoyment since the Temple was built in 1926.

Tailored to its particular environment, our Tschantz Pipe Organ is rather small when compared to many of its relatives located in churches throughout the local area; yet it posses the power and character to thrill and inspire all who hear and sit at its Manuals.

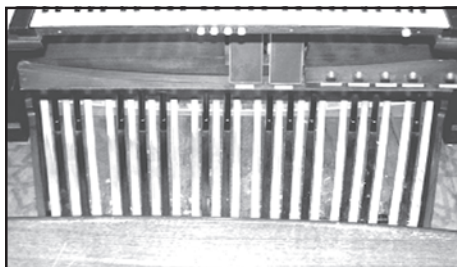
The two manual, 12 rank instrument was created and installed by the Tschantz (Schantz) Organ Company of Orrville, Ohio in 1925. The console was rebuilt in 1962 to upgrade the instrument to a more positive response and better reliability. Pictured is the **Grand Manual** (lower key board) with the following stops which can be selected: Great Manual; Harp, Cornopean 8', Flautina 2', Nazard 2 2/3', Dulciana 4', Violina 4', Flute 4', Octave 4', Dulciana 8', Viol 8', Gedackt 8', Open Diapason 8', Contra Dulciana 16', Contra Viol 16' and Bourdon 16'; all while the organ is being played for different effects.

The Swell Manual (top keyboard) has the following stops: Vox Humana 8'. Oboe 8', Flautina 2', Dulciana 4', Violina 4', Flute 4', Dulciana 8', Vox Celeste 8', Viol 8', Gedackt 8', Contra Dulciana 16', Contra Viol 16', and Bourdon 16'. These are the sounds which create the harmony and rhythm to the music as a whole.

The Pedal (lower foot keyboard on the floor) contains the following stops: Oboe 8', Cornopean 8', Principal 4', Dulciana 8', Viol 8', Dolce Flute 8', Bass Flute 8', Open Diapason 8', Lieblich Gedackt 8', and Bourdon 16'. These are the very low vibrating sounds which can be felt and assist in maintaining the beat of the music.

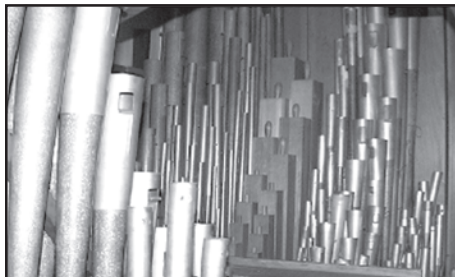

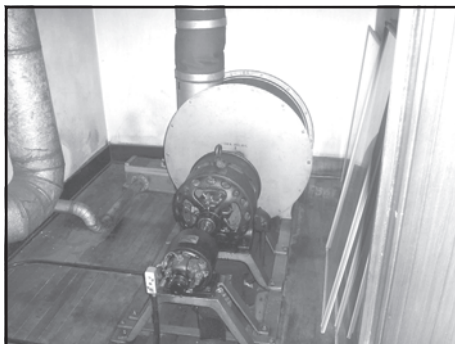

Pictured are the instrument's **wind chests** and are equipped with electro-pneumatic valves, added some years later to improve response but, the remainder of the organ remains the same as when it was installed. The instrument is equipped with a light tremolo adding a pleasing "chorus" effect to the wide variety of traditional voices and the Harp adds a deep richness to the special musical requirements it is called upon to perform. Many of the wind chests, being made of wood, require a humid atmosphere to maintain proper sound control. Although once tuned, it requires little attention as long as the humidity is kept somewhat constant and the instrument is exercised often.

The wind power is supplied by a **motor driven blower** (pictured,) not a compressor because volume is required not high pressure, located in a near by room adjacent to the wind chests. The brethren will note the "pony" motor required to start the main unit because of the size of the impeller. This location reduces the mechanical noise of machinery to the listener and adds the mystic and mystery of the wonderful full bodied sound which is not only heard but felt in the listening area.
