





Could We Lose The Masonic Temple?

The Reverend Dr. William Watt was born February 2, 1946 in Boston, Massachusetts. At age ten he and his family moved to the suburban town of Wilmington, where he lived until graduation from Seminary in 1970.

Dr. Watt attended the Wilmington Public Schools and then The New Preparatory School in Cambridge, Massachusetts. In 1967 he was graduated from Gordon College with a B.A. Degree in History and was subsequently certified to teach in that field. During the summer of 1969 he attended the Summer Institute at the Free University of Amsterdam, Holland. In 1970 he was graduated from Gordon-

Conwell Theological Seminary with a M. Div. Degree. He later received a D. Min Degree from Bethany Theological Seminary in 1983.

Following ordination by the Boston Presbytery of the United Presbyterian Church (USA) in September of 1970, William, his wife, the former Priscilla Trowbridge and their three-month old son, William Jr., left for their first church in Kirklin, Indiana. During their ministry in Indiana, their second son, James, was born.

In the summer of 1972 the Watt family moved to Fredericktown, Ohio for an eight-year pastorate.

Dr. Watt has served the Presbyterian Church in numerous capacities; as a commissioner to the Synod of Indiana and later to the Synod of the Covenant; as chairperson of the Interpretation and Stewardship Committee of Scioto Valley Presbytery, and later in the Muskingum Valley Presbytery; a member of the Synod of the Covenant's Division of Administration, a member of the Division of Planning, and as a member of the Synod's Staff review and evaluation committee; a member of the Committee on Ministry in Muskingum Valley Presbytery.

He has served each community in which he has lived: as President of the Knox County Ministerial Association, Vice President of the Fredericktown Parent Teachers Organization, a member of the Lions International and President of the Canton Association of Churches.

On April 15, 1980, Dr. Watt became the third minister of the Presbyterian Church of the Covenant in Canton, Ohio.

Dr. Watt has traveled extensively through Europe and the British Isles and explores this country as time allows. In June of 1997 Dr. Watt visited Israel with a group from Malone College. 
